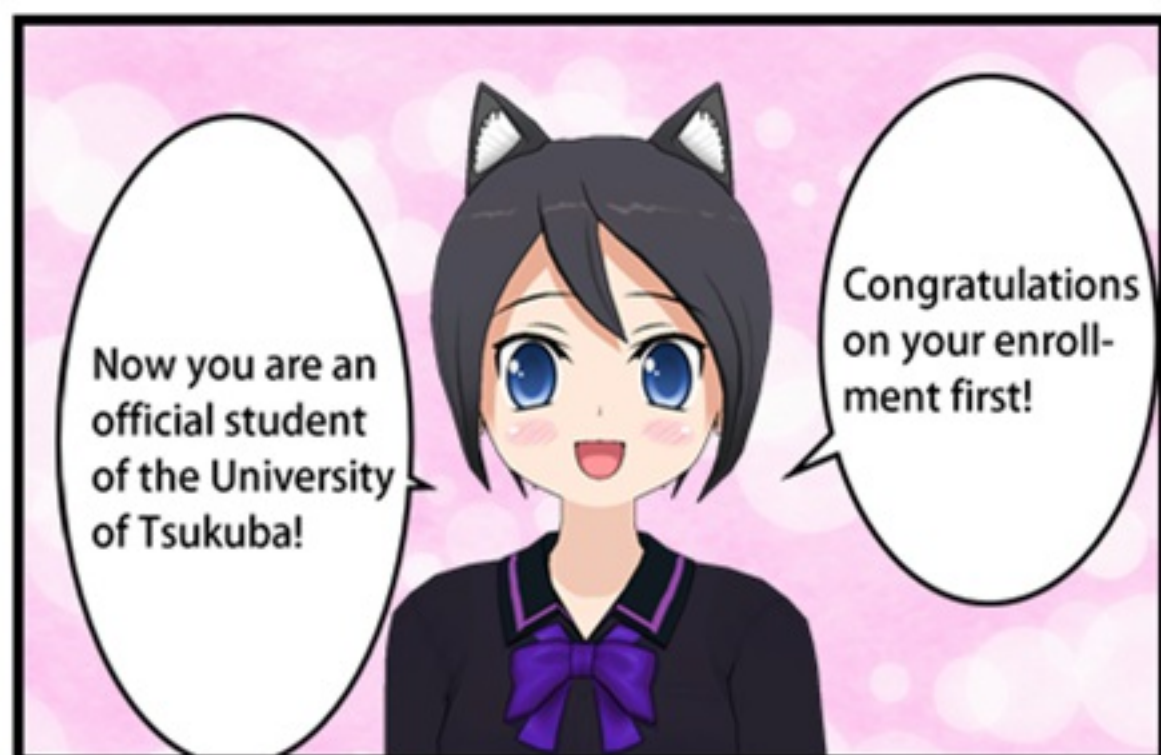
On the day of enrollment ceremony

Senpai, I got my account.



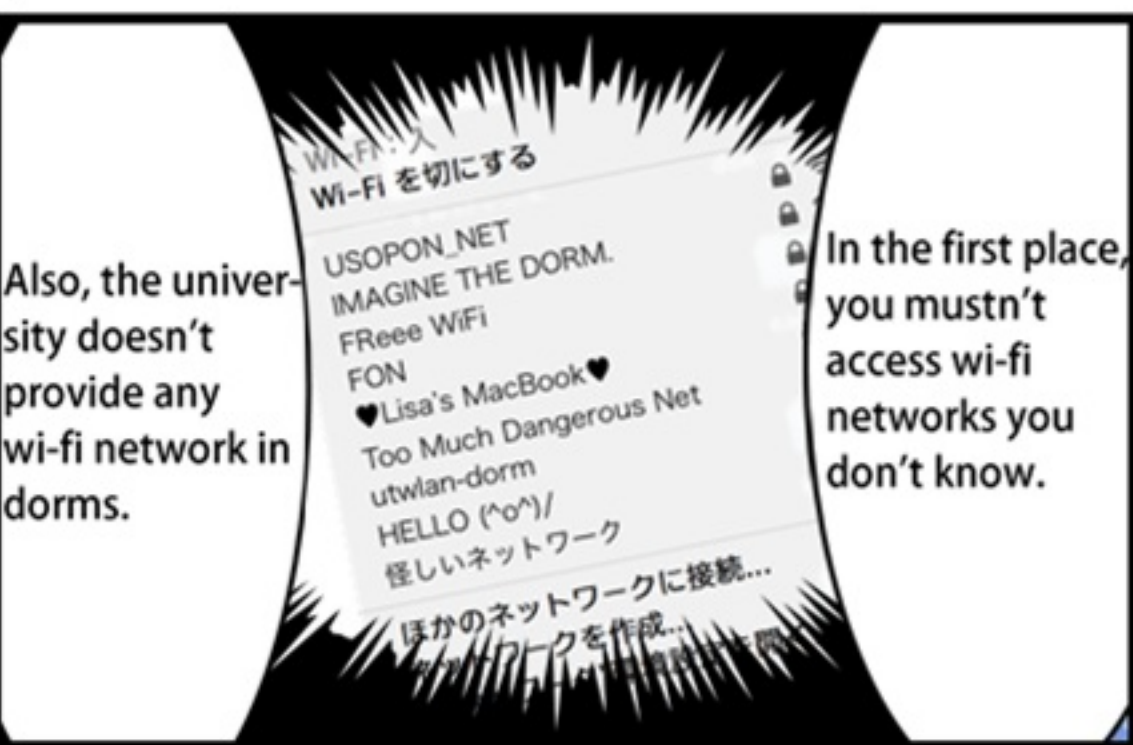
Unfortunately, quite a few students are using them.

No way. Routers and wi-fi are banned in dorm rooms.



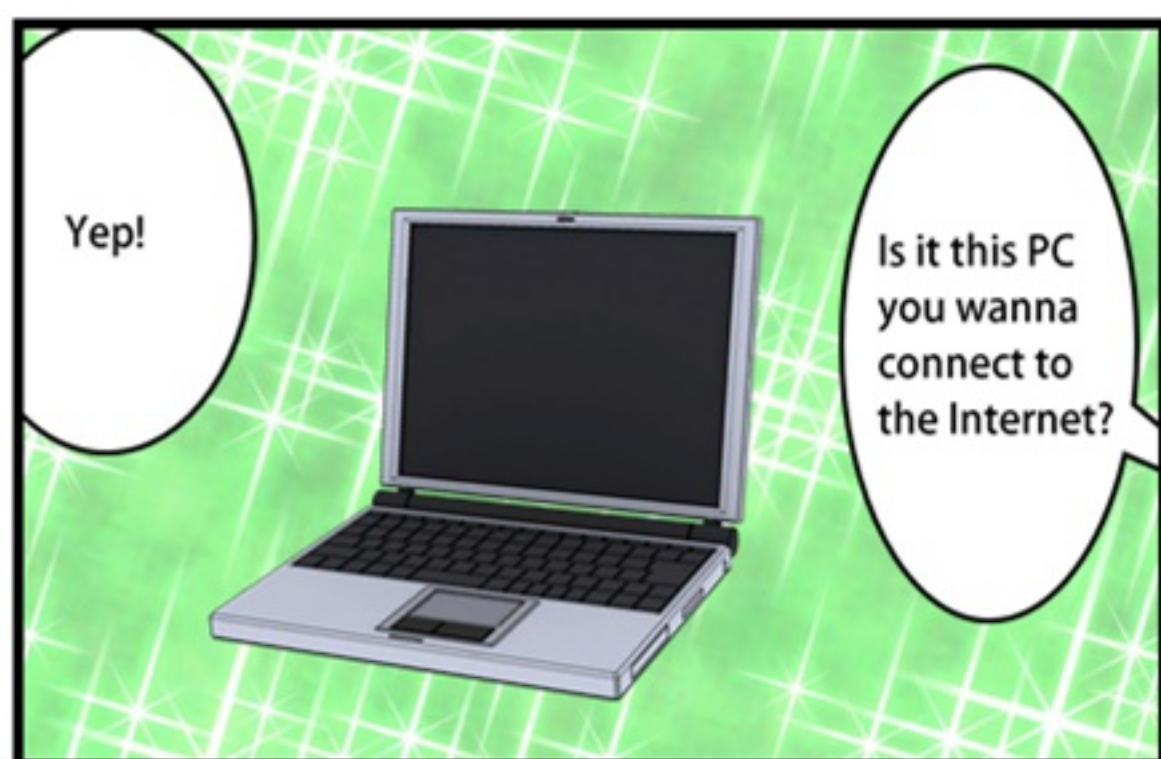
Now you are an official student of the University of Tsukuba!

Congratulations on your enrollment first!



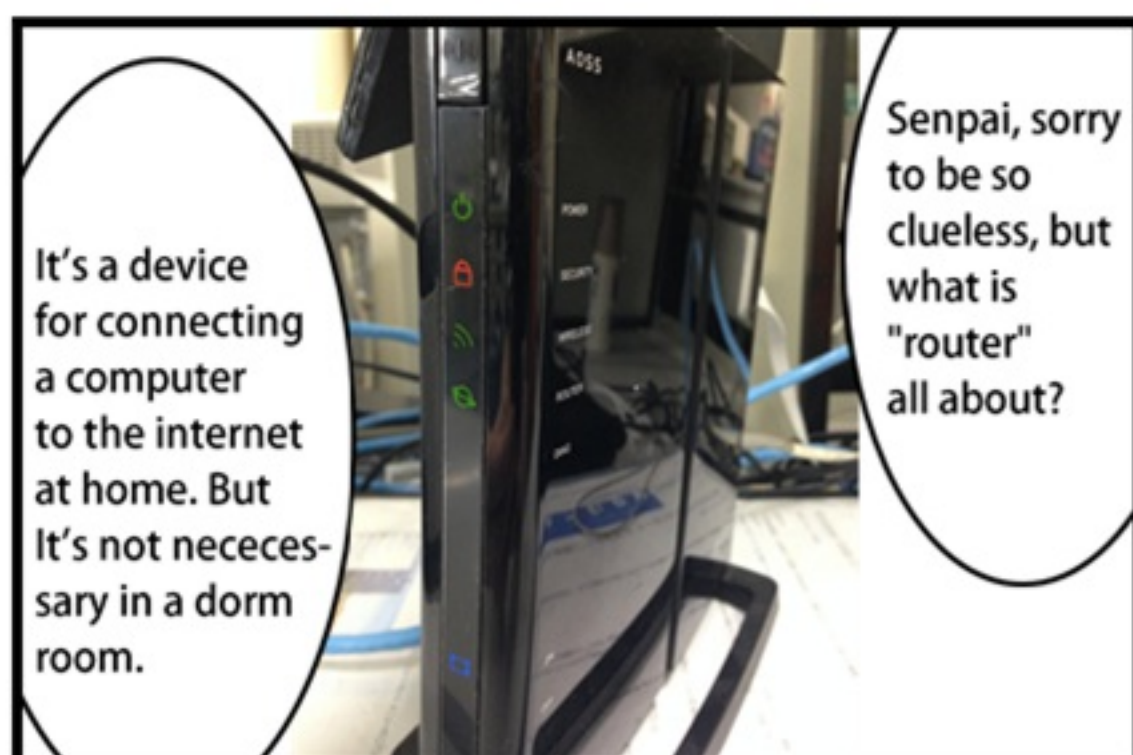
Also, the university doesn't provide any wi-fi network in dorms.

Is it this PC you wanna connect to the Internet?



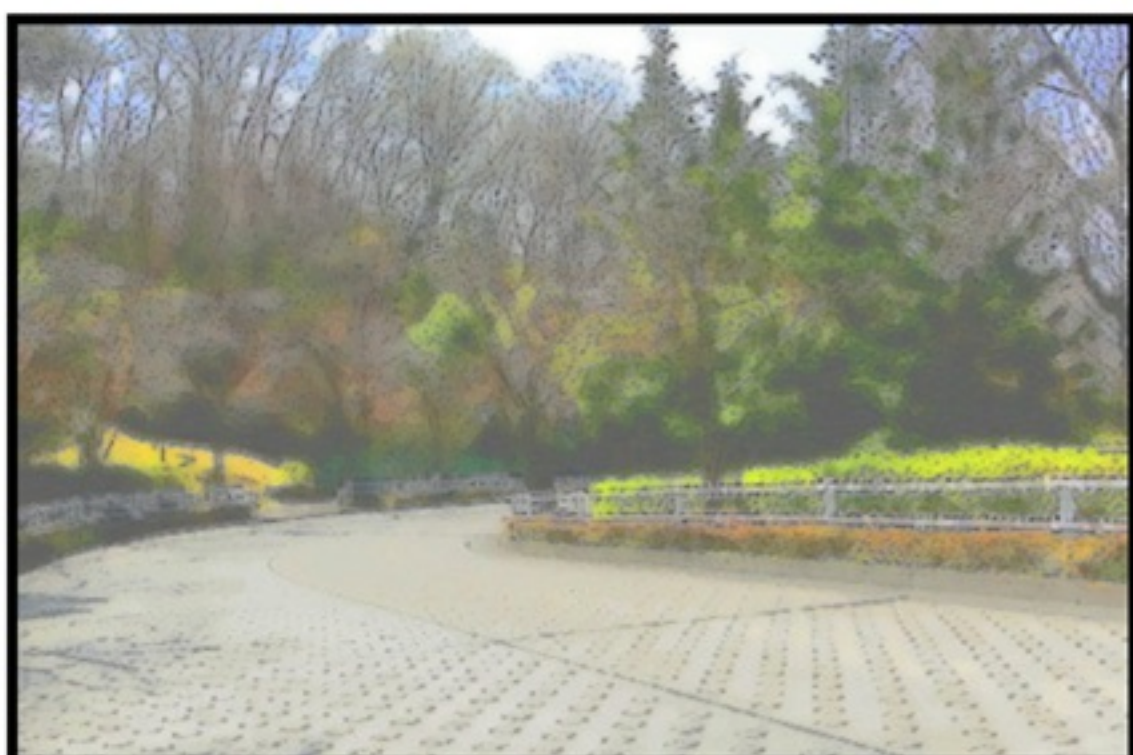
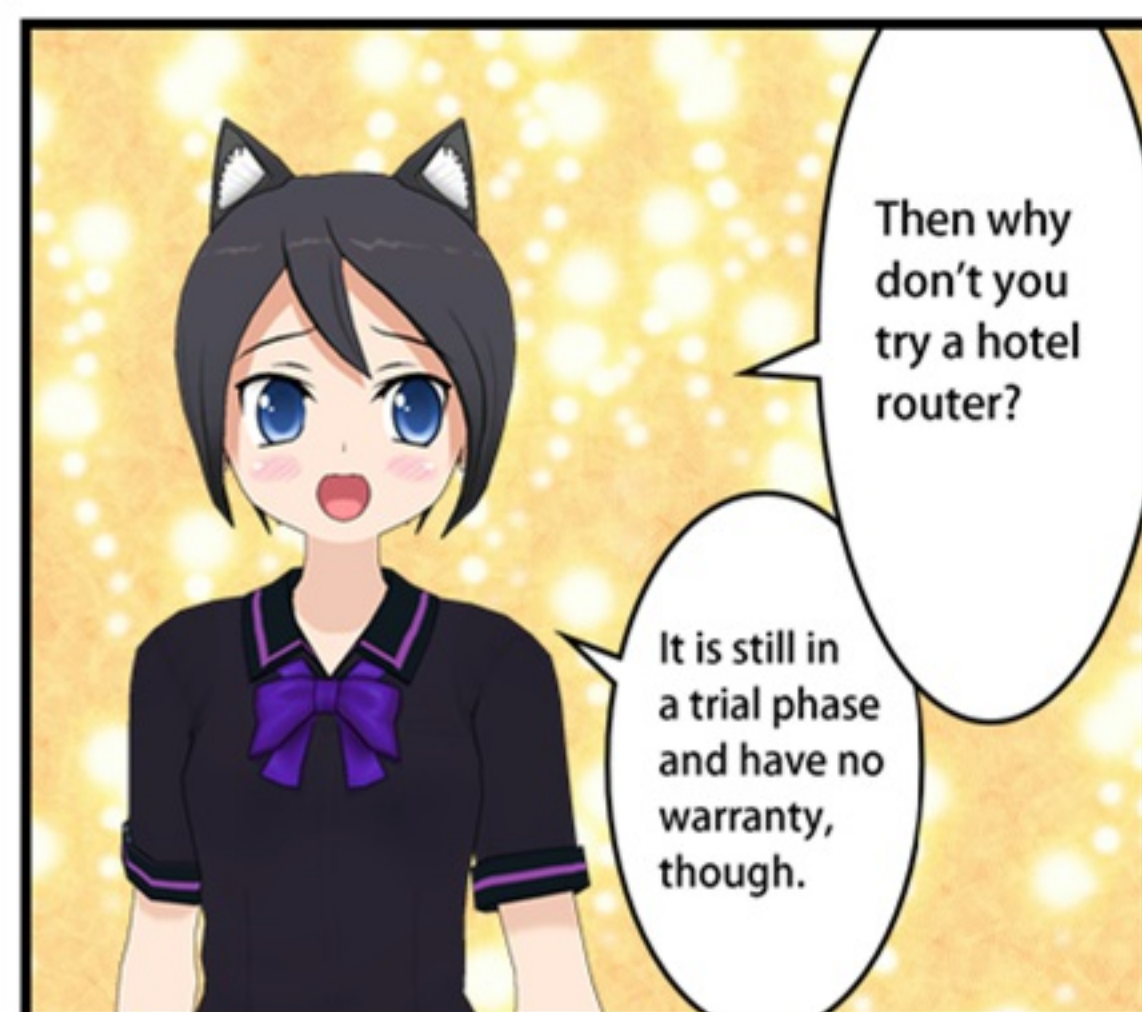
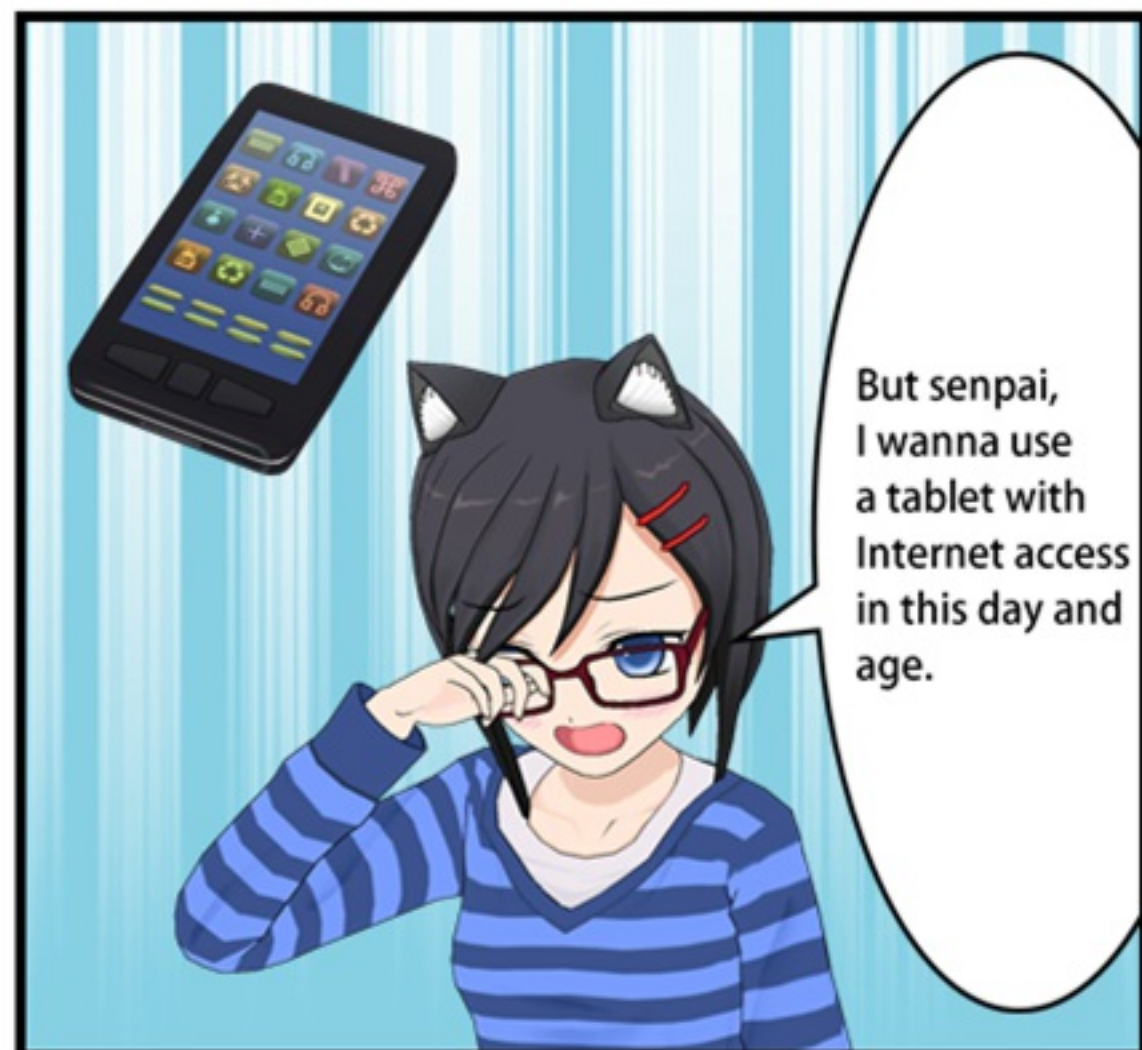
It's a device for connecting a computer to the internet at home. But It's not necessary in a dorm room.

Senpai, sorry to be so clueless, but what is "router" all about?

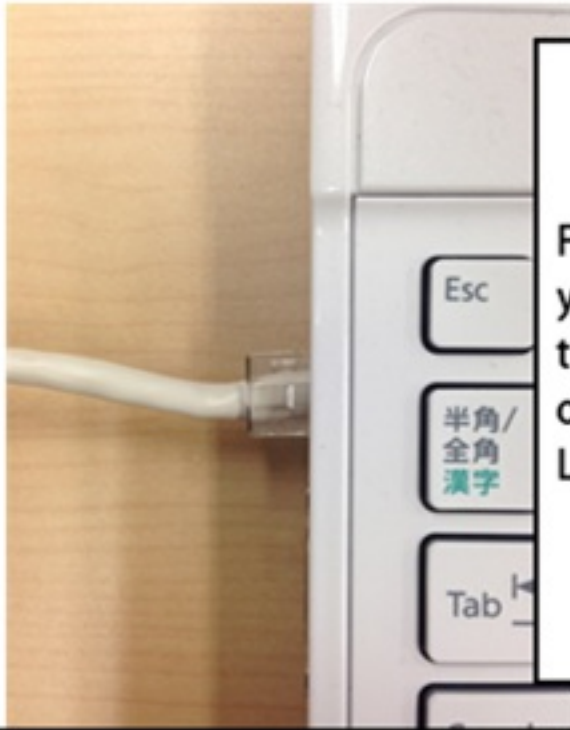


You are supposed to get one for yourself.

... just kidding.

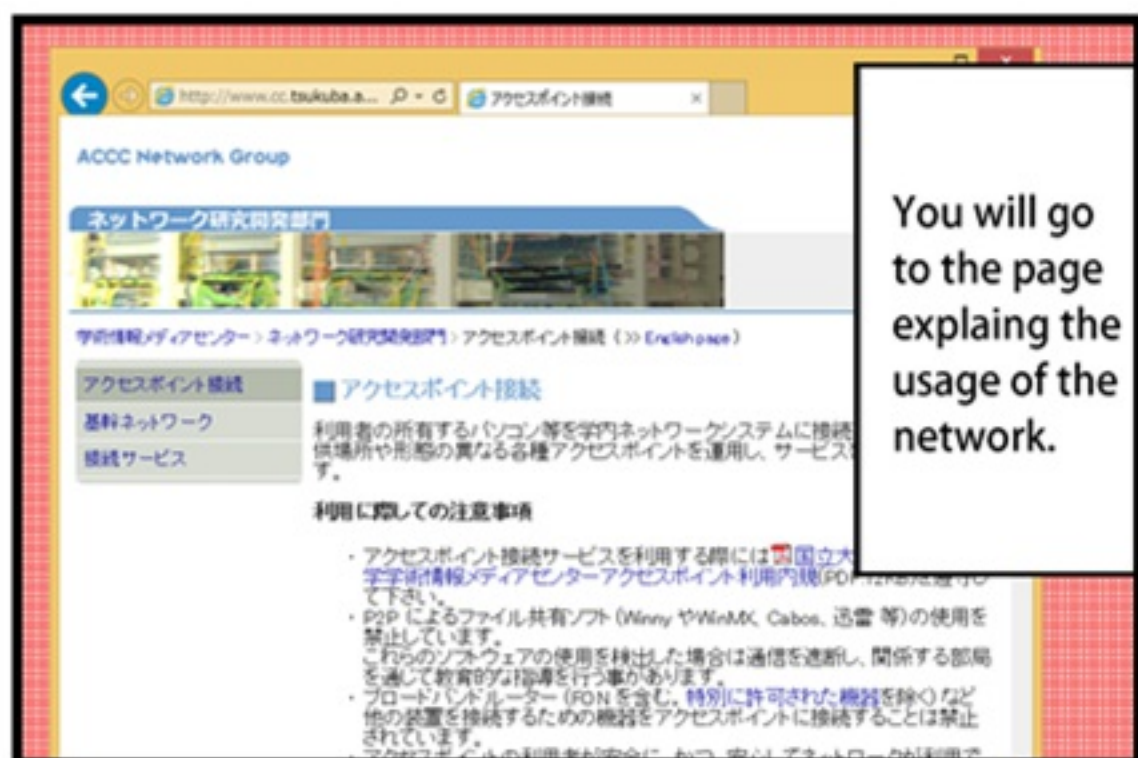
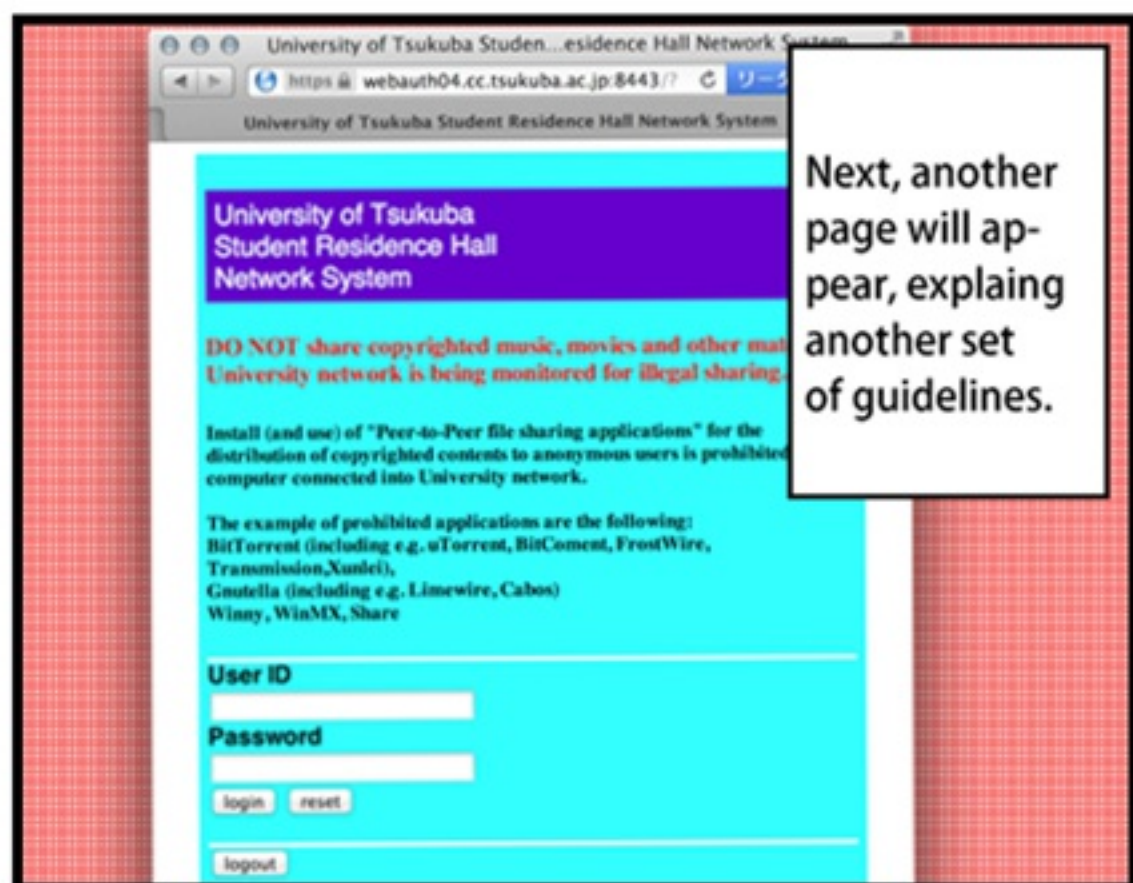

It's an application that allows you to use the Internet such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome or Safari. Run the one you usually use on your PC.

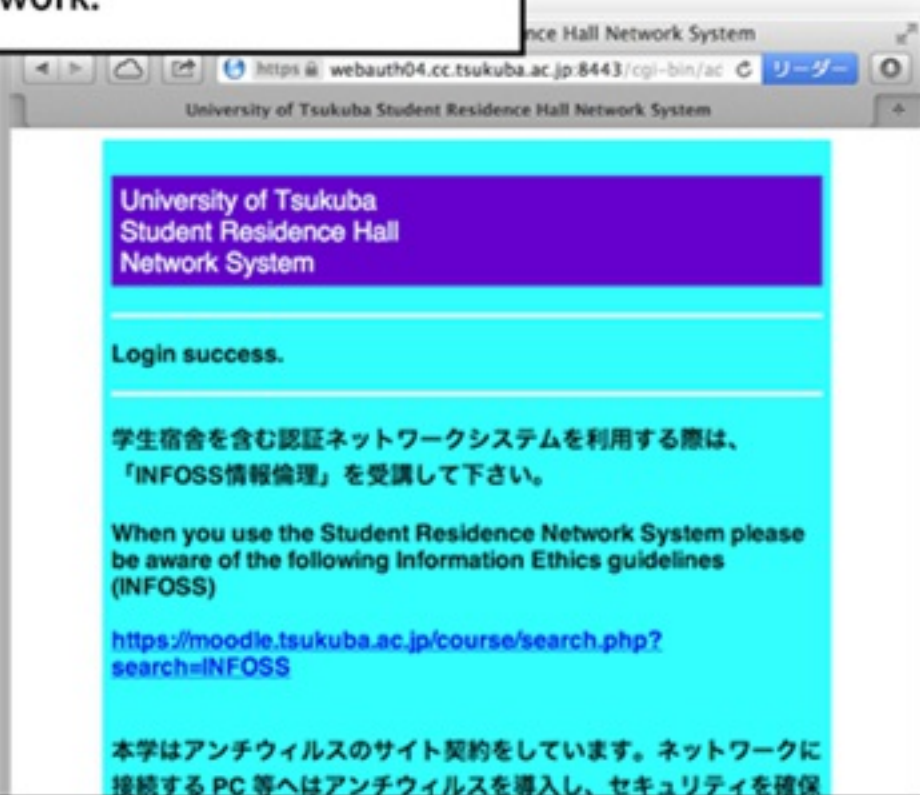
Well, let's get started.

Getting back on the track—click on log-in after entering your 13 digits and password.

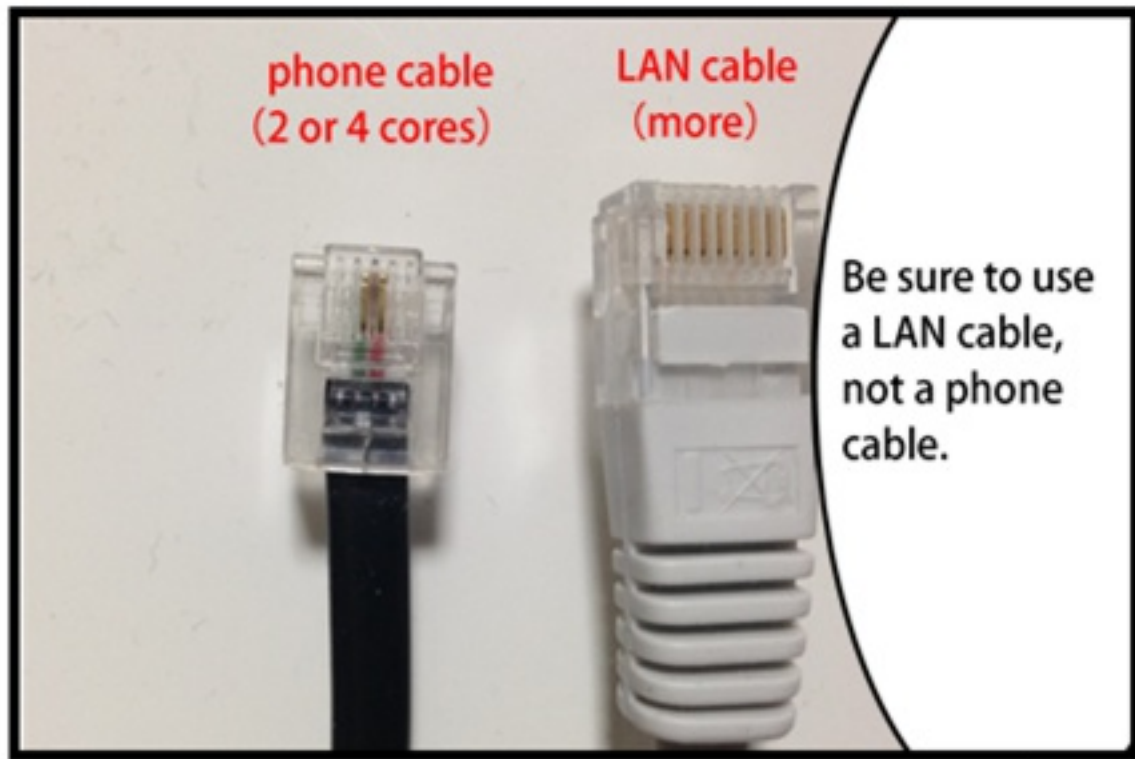
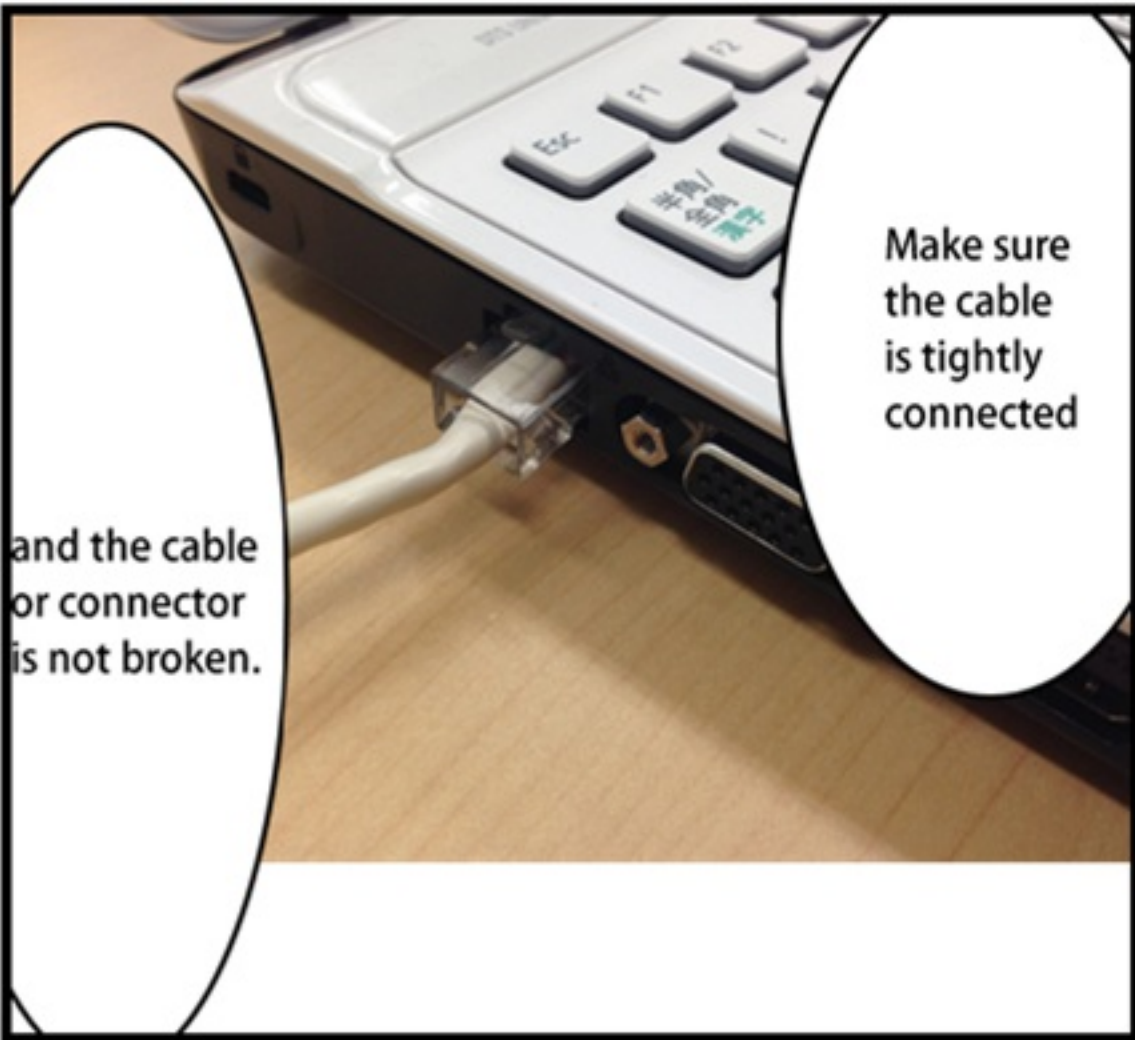

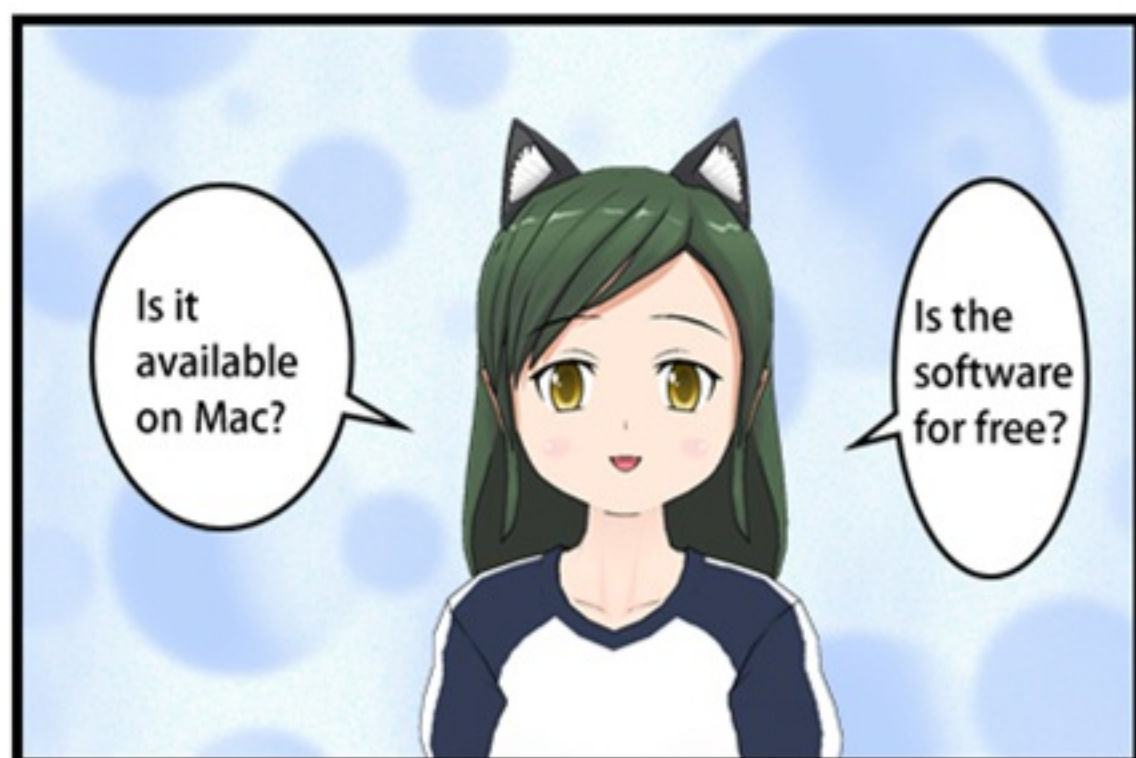
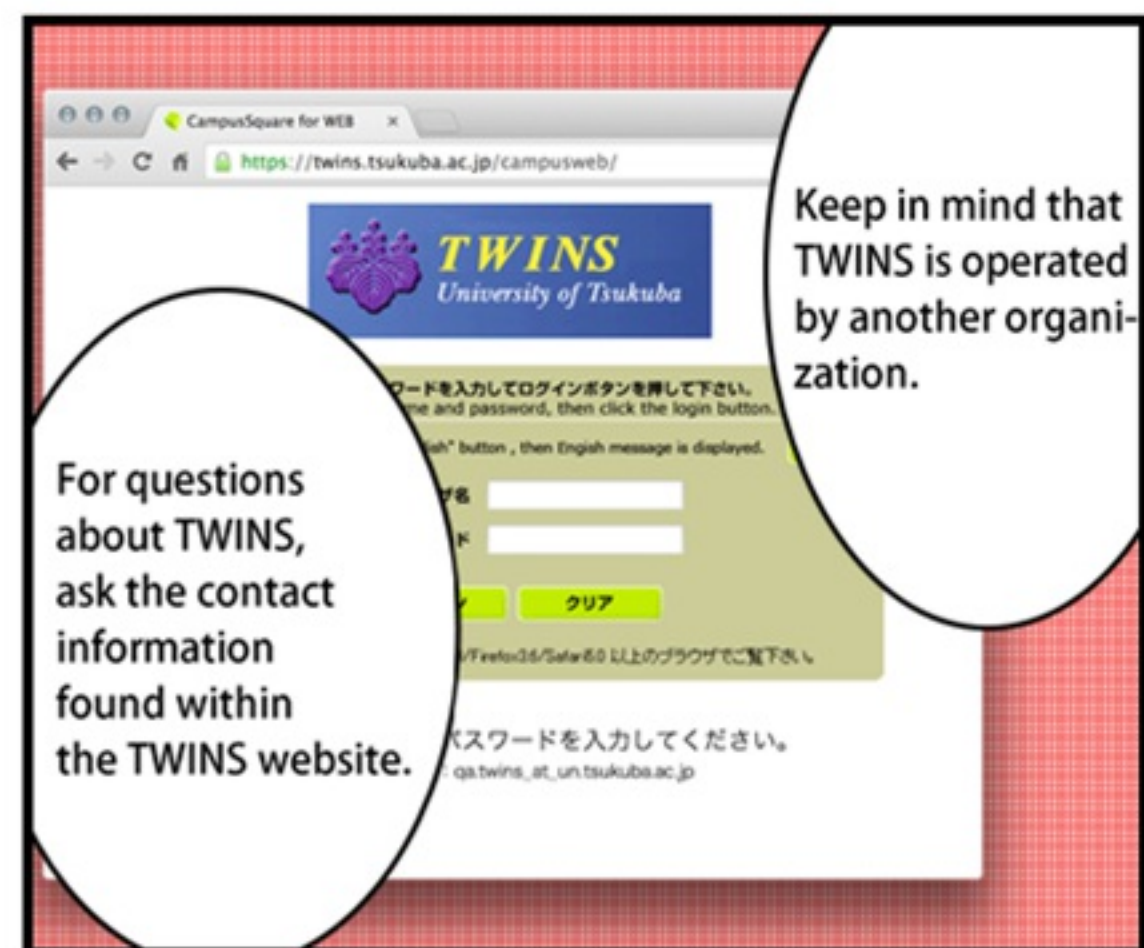
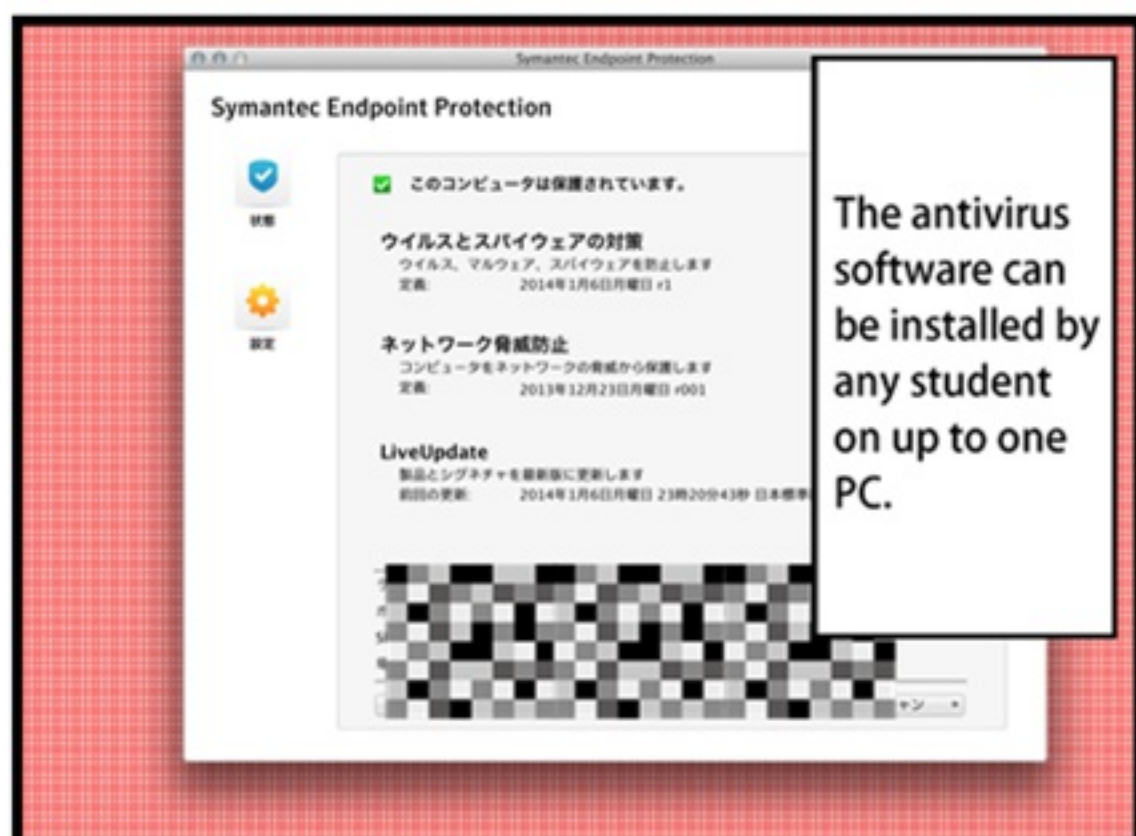














## Peer-to-Peer File Sharing Software (P2P) & Copyright

That means if you download an illegal file via P2P,

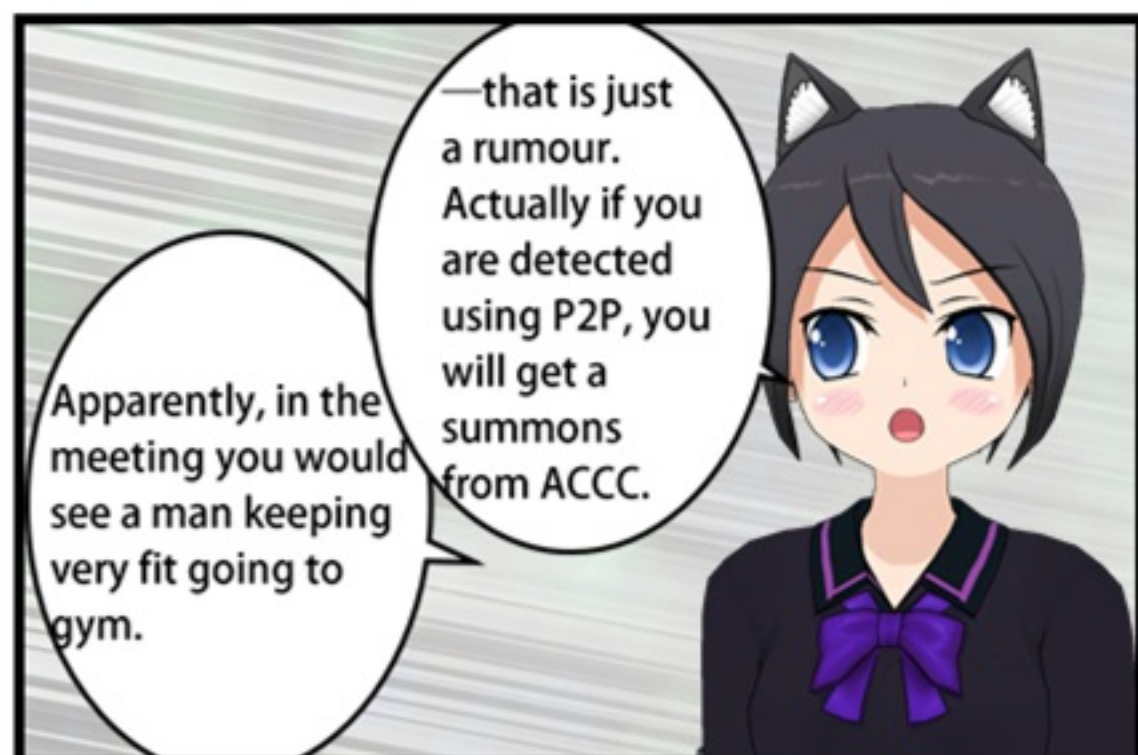
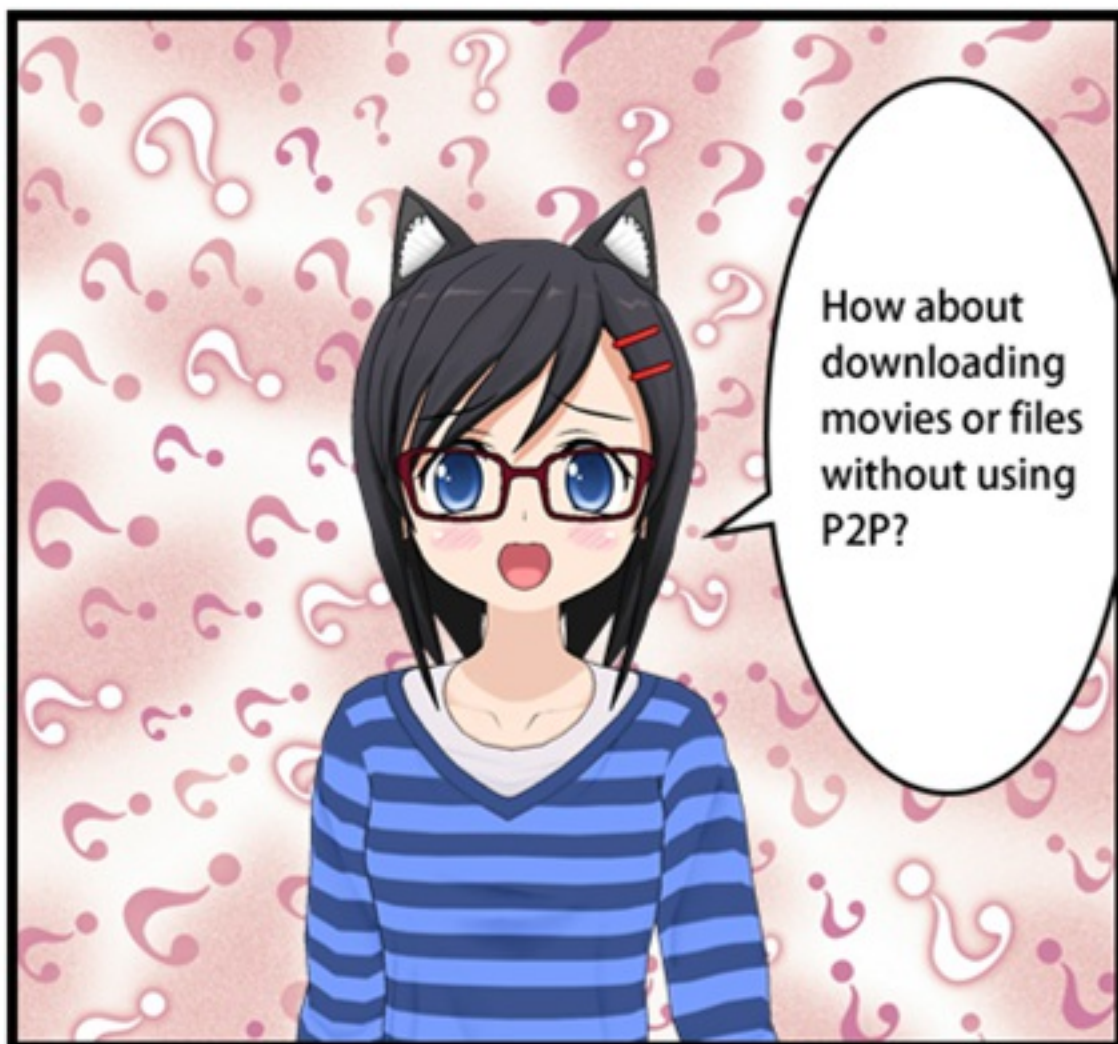

Nowadays there are more and more official videos available, but you should guess for yourself which is OK, and which is not.



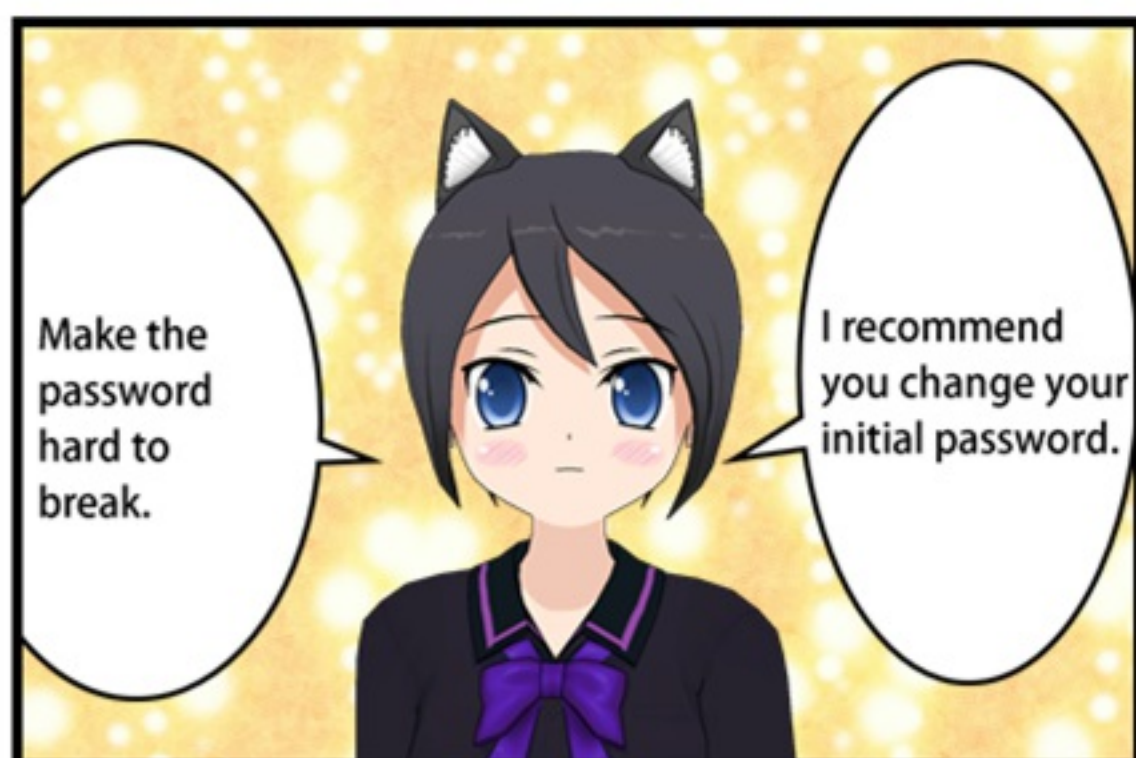
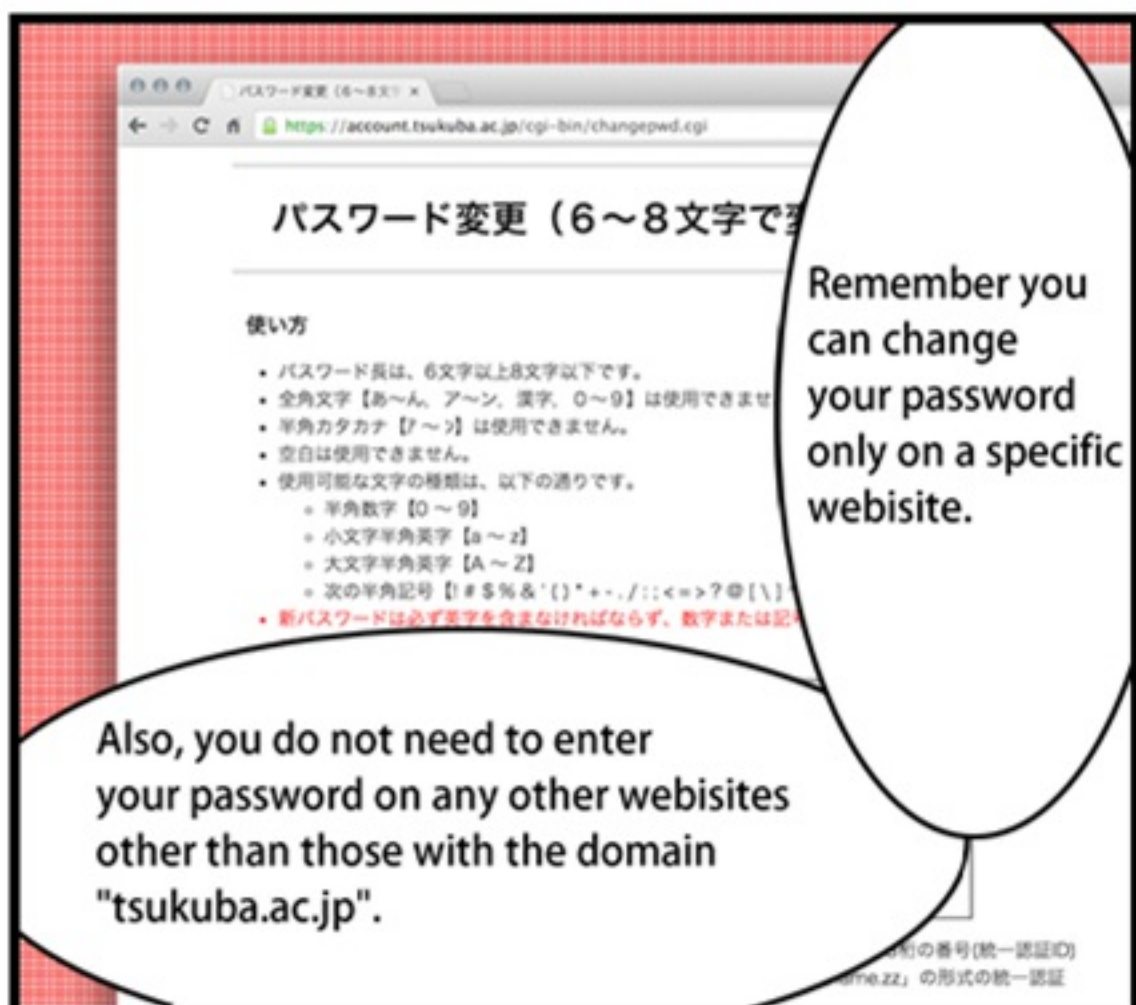
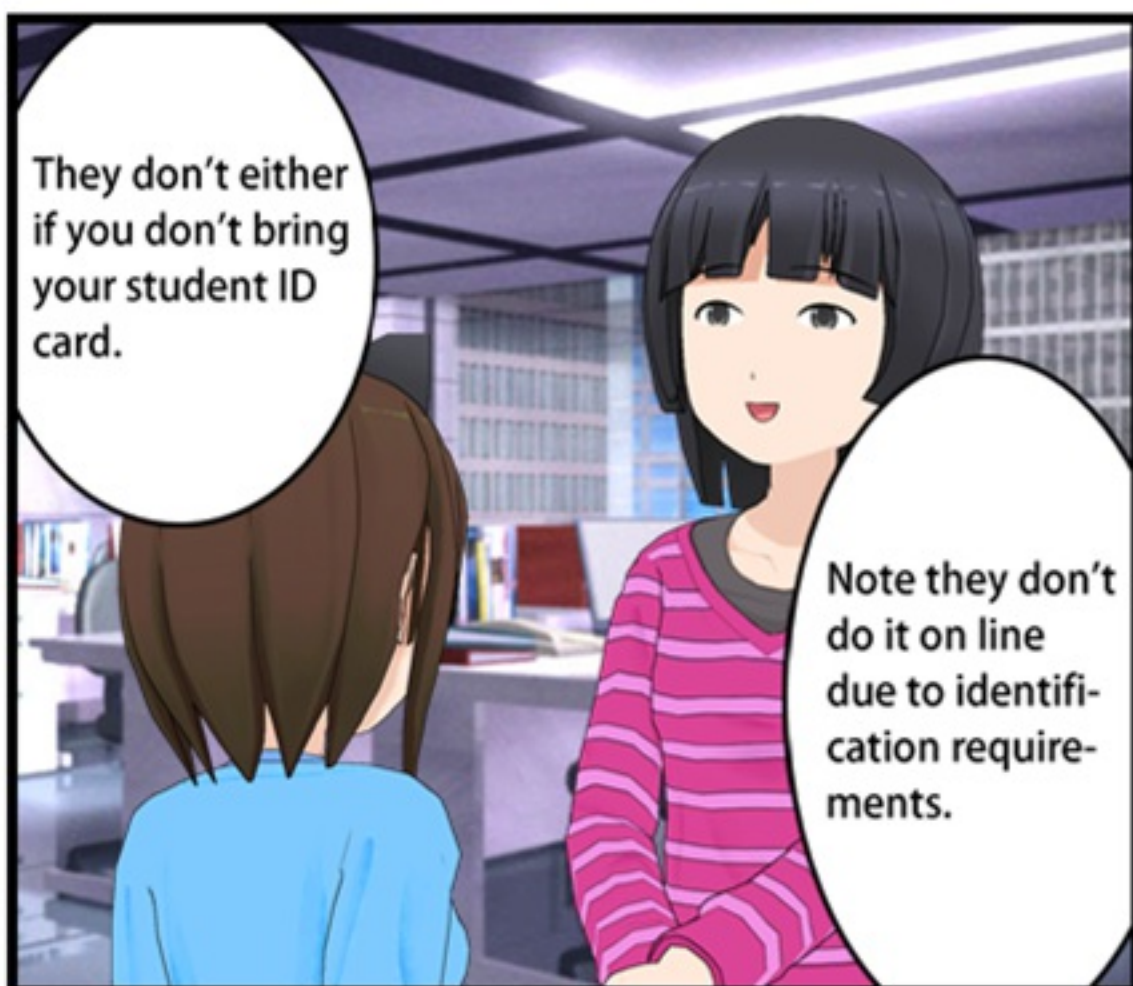
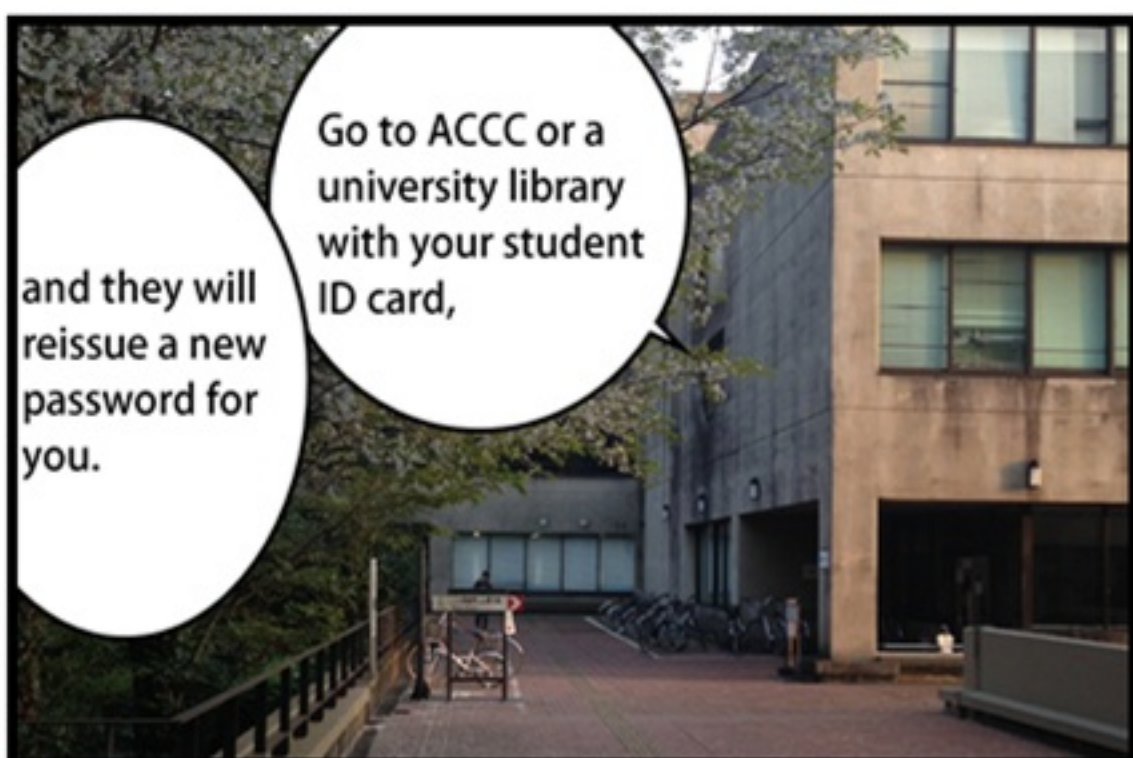
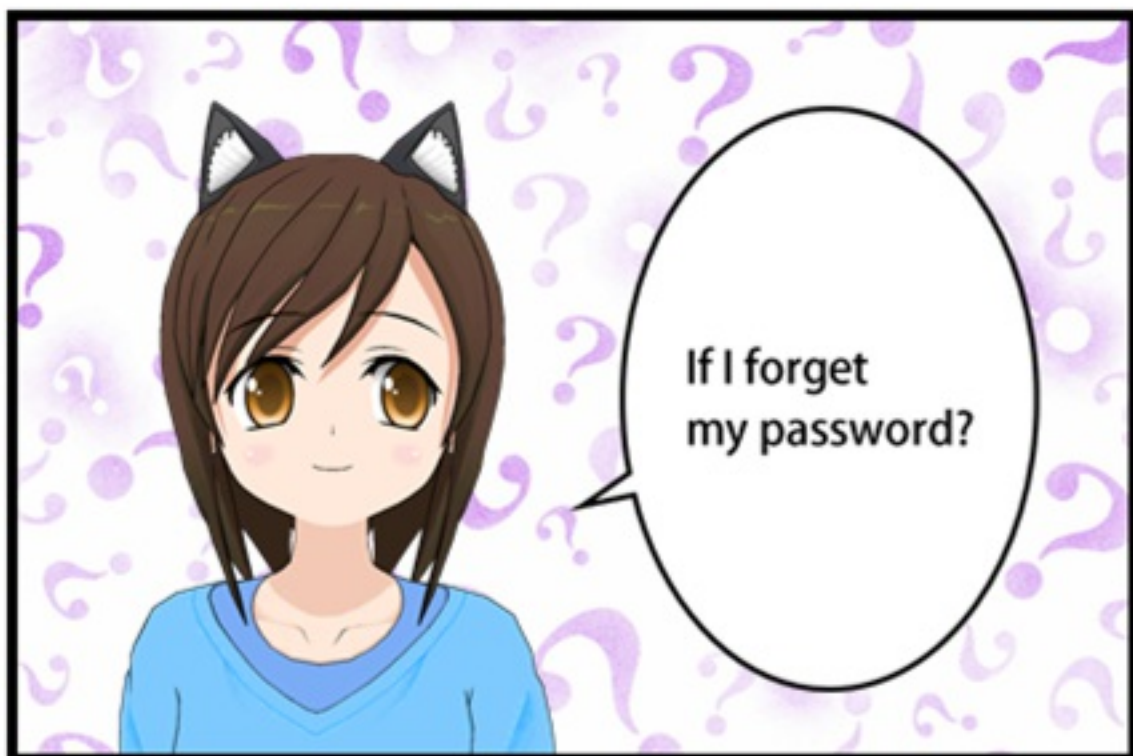
Your account might be misused later, if not right now.

As long as you follow the rules, you can watch such movies as you want.

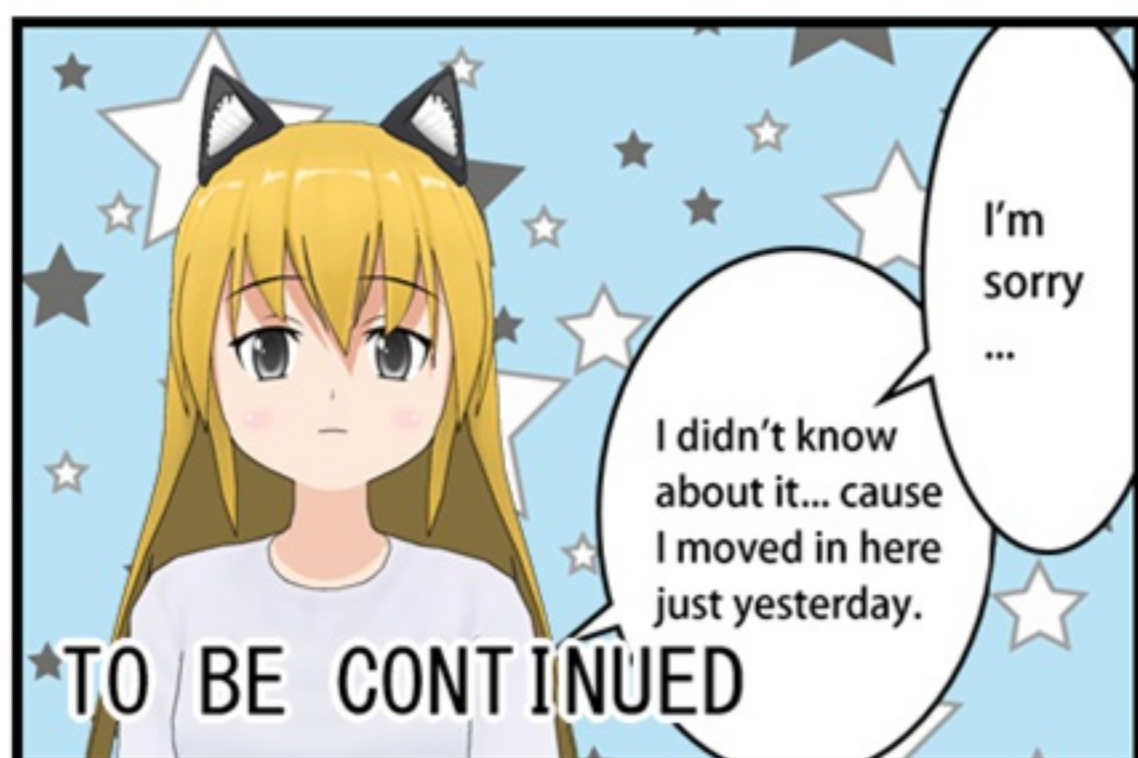
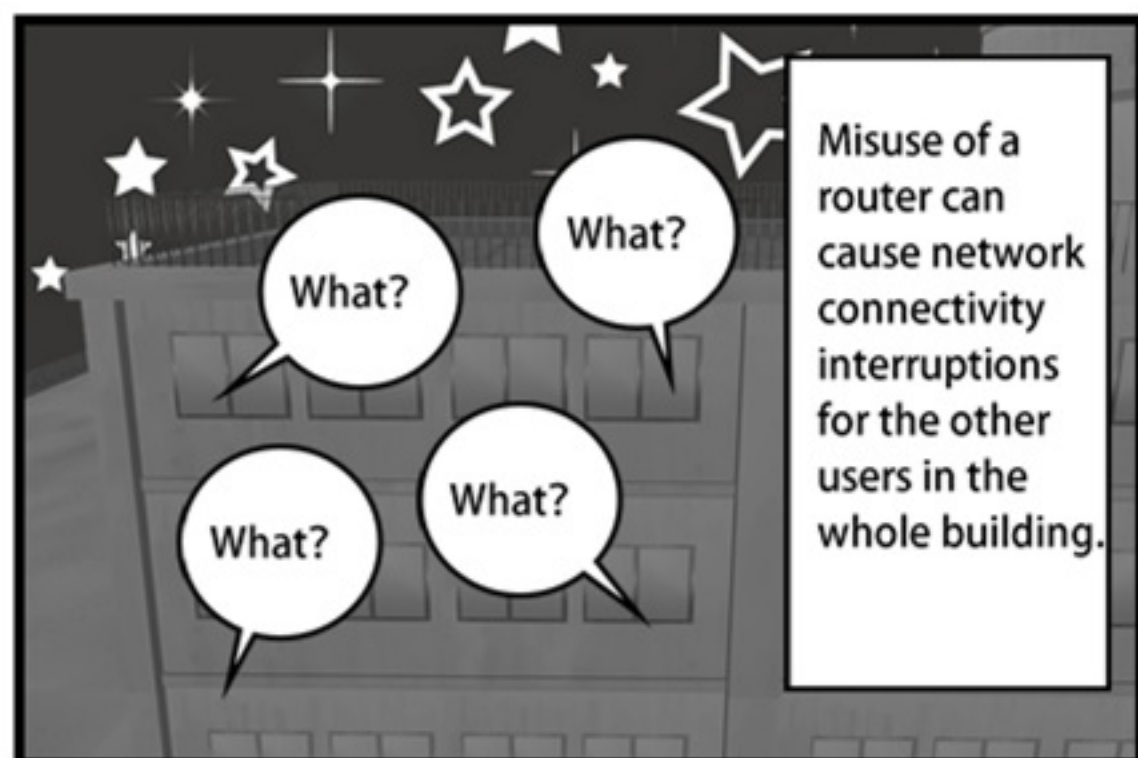
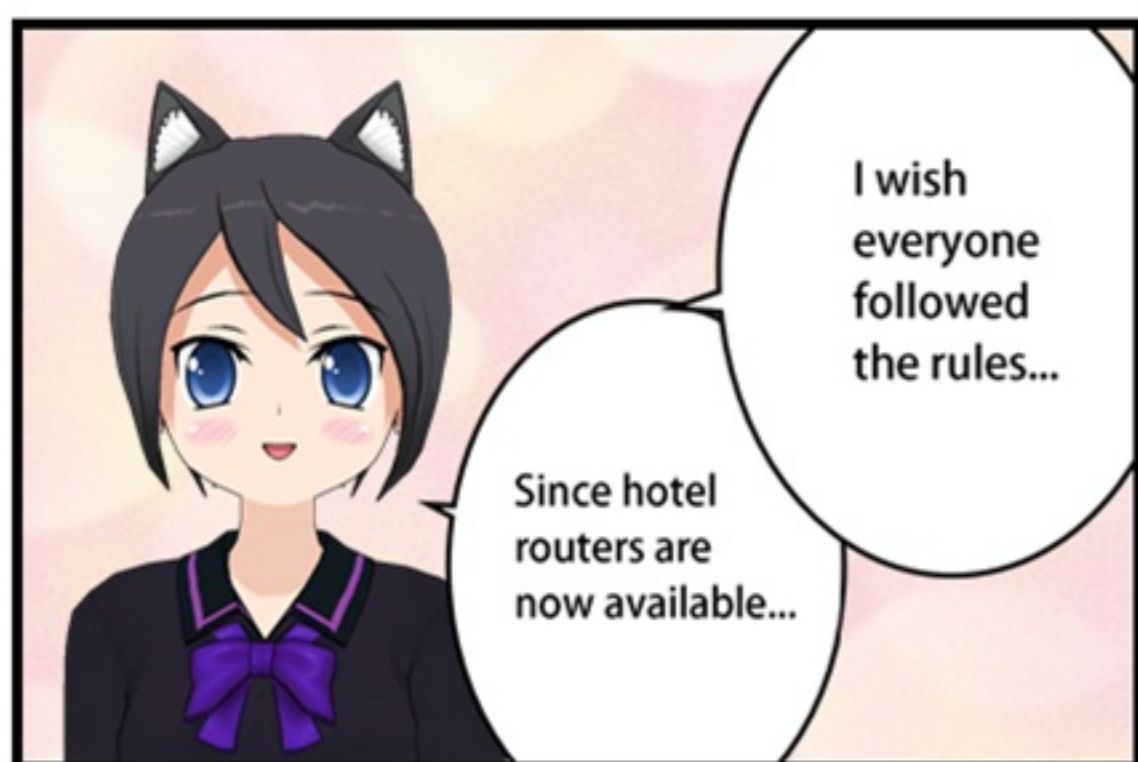
