

8. Zengaku Computer System

“Automatic screen lock and shutdown of terminals”

Screen lock and automatic sign-out/log-out/shutdown features have been installed in the Zengaku Computer System terminals.

- After a certain period of time without operating the terminal, a screen saver is activated and the screen is locked.
- In order to return to the original screen from the locked screen, the password must be entered.
- If a certain amount of time passes without unlocking the lock, a sign-out/log-out is automatically executed. This may cause the unsaved data to disappear.
- After signing out/logging out, if no user has signed in/logged in and the idle time reaches a certain amount of time, the terminal will automatically shut down.
- The user can also lock the screen with his or her own operation.
- Detailed information such as the length of time for each can be found on the Zengaku Computer System webpage.

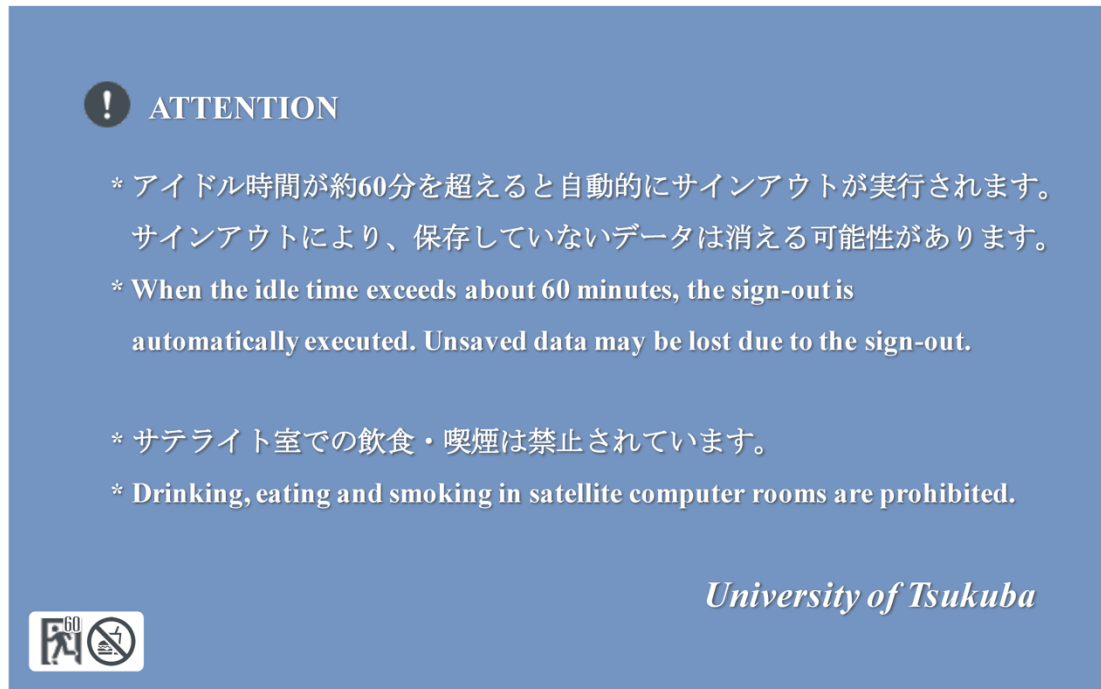


Figure 8.26 Screen displayed by screen saver (Windows environment)

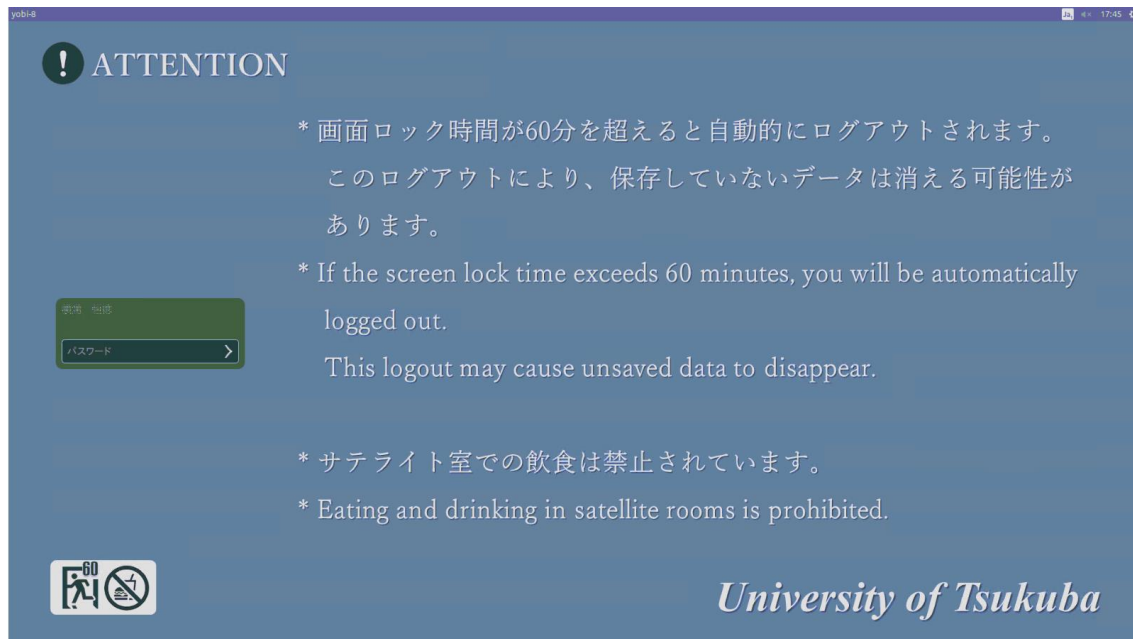


Figure 8.27 Screen displayed by screen saver (Linux environment)
